ROOT CANAL THERAPY
(endodontic treatment)

This procedure was performed to save the tooth by removing the damaged pulp (nerve) that has become irreversibly damaged or infected. This could be due to a cavity, or caused by deep decay, a crack or chipped tooth, tooth trauma or repeated dental procedures on said tooth.

The treated tooth may be tender to chewing for the next few days. The sensitivity or discomfort usually can be controlled with over-the-counter pain medication. This is normal and your discomfort should diminish in a few days.
